- ➔ Automated External Defibrillation (AED)
- ➔ Aspirin Administration
- ➔ Perform two-rescuer adult, child and infant
- ➔ Demonstrate a pulse check
- ➔ Demonstrate jaw thrust airway
- ➔ Show the administration of oxygen via a bag valve mask
- ➔ Cricoid Pressure
- ➔ Pediatric AED
